Mold Dairy Sale ~ Monday 9th February 2026

An excellent entry of 20 quality dairy cattle was presented, comprising 15 fresh heifers, 3 fresh cows (2nd calvers), and 2 in-calf heifers. They met a good range of buyers ringside, with all sections well covered. While prices are certainly not what they were 2 months ago for obvious reasons, it was still a very pleasing day's trading, with 9 animals making £2,000 or more.

Top price on the day was £2,300 for a fresh heifer from Jones, Hendy, Caernarfon. Calved on 21 January, she was giving 34 litres and was sired by Denovo Aster.

The same farm also sold the top-priced cow, a 2nd calver making £2,280. Sired by Denovo Atlantis, she had calved on 29 January and was giving 43 litres, having completed her first lactation of 8,700 litres at 4.93% butterfat and 3.29% protein.

Jones, Hendy went on to sell a further heifer at £2,250 and a 2nd calver at £2,200.

In third place making £2,250 was a 2nd calver from Roberts, Tyn Celyn, Gwyddelwern, sired by Delinace, calved 17 days and giving 41 litres. A heifer from the same farm, calved 16 days and giving 35 litres, made £2,150.

Also worthy of mention was Evans, Tyn Cae, Bodedern, selling a fresh-calved heifer for £2,150.

Finally, Roberts, Oakmount sold a young heifer calved 16 days, giving 29 kg, for £2,000.

The two in-calf heifers, both due mid-March, sold for £1,880 (sexed semen) and £1,650 (Angus).
