

Market Report

Mold Dairy Sale ~ Monday 13th April 2026



A strong entry of 25 dairy cattle forward this week, comprising 23 freshly calved heifers and 2 fresh cows. The offering included numerous quality animals, attracting a large ring of buyers and resulting in a brisk and competitive trade throughout.

Leading the day's trade at £2,700 was a standout heifer from Jones, Llys Dinmael Isaf, Corwen. This Moor Farm, Holywell-bred animal, sired by Aladdin and backed by 10 generations of VG/EX dams, had calved 14 days prior and was yielding 27 litres. From the same farm, another quality commercial heifer, also bred by Moor Farm, achieved £2,620, having calved one week and producing 24 litres. Further heifers from this consignment sold well at £2,210 and £2,100.

Parry, Sychdyn Farm, Tremeirchion, continued to present quality stock, with an Applejax-sired heifer selling for £2,550 and a Sasafra daughter achieving £2,320.

Evans, Erw Fawr, marketed a strong run of homebred heifers, topped by a Tulip-sired animal at £2,500. This heifer, three weeks calved and yielding 33 litres, drew significant interest. Others from the same consignment sold to £2,400.

Roberts, Hafod Henllan, sold a smart pedigree homebred heifer sired by Harvest, calved one week and producing 30 litres, for £2,450.

Roberts, Plas ym Mhowys, continued the dispersal of their herd, offering three heifers (two Norwegian Red and one Holstein Friesian cross), all of which sold between £2,150 and £2,200.

Overall, a very pleasing day's trading, with strong demand for quality, freshly calved heifers reflected in the firm prices achieved across the board.
